 Survey sent out in Summer 2020 to about 64,000 participants

 Almost 50,000 were returned → 78% response rate. Thank you!



#### Age at survey completion


Mean age = 84 (71-104)


#### **COVID Survey Respondents: Current residence**






#### Difficulties in taking medication
