Item ¹	WHI statement
Will individual participant data be available (including data dictionaries)?	Deidentified individual participant data is available.
What data in particular will be shared?	All of the deidentified participant data collected during the trial.
What other documents will be available?	Study protocol, study procedures, data collection forms and other documents.
When will data be available (start and end dates)?	Data is available through the WHI online resource, https://www.whi.org/datasets , while the WHI remains funded ² and indefinitely through BioLINCC, https://biolincc.nhlbi.nih.gov/studies/whi_ctos/ .
With whom?	Eligible researchers ³ may download the data directly at the WHI online resource. Other researchers may download the publicly available data through BioLINCC, in accordance with NHLBI's BioLINCC guidelines .
For what types of analyses?	Eligible researchers ³ with an approved specified purpose. Other researchers in accordance with NHLBI's BioLINCC guidelines .
By what mechanism will data be made available?	Data are available at the aforementioned links.
